Eligible Artists

This event is open to all **GEORGIA** based artists with disabilities. Professional, non-professional, and group art projects will be accepted.

Eligible Work

Artwork for consideration includes:

- Drawing
- Fabric Design
- Jewelry
- Metalsmithing
- Needlework
- Painting

- Photography
- Printmaking
- Sculpture
- Weaving
- Wood Carving

Only original works of art will be judged. Pre-designed pieces, when identified, will be rejected. Work must have been completed by August 29, 2025, and not previously shown in this exhibit.

Work Size, Two-Dimensional Art

Measurement of any two-dimensional artwork can be no larger than 48" wide by 48" tall, including frame. Weight not to exceed 15 pounds.

Presentation:

All two-dimensional artwork <u>must be framed and</u> ready to hang with wiring attached. Sculpture must be able to stand on its own with or without a base. Cover cases should accompany the work. Fiber art must be equipped for hanging.

Submission of Artwork

Artwork will need to be <u>PHOTOGRAPHED</u> and submitted to the email address below for review as we need to ensure that artwork meets guidelines and does not violate any policies of the Roswell Visual Arts Center.

The deadline to submit ALL photographed entries is by August 29, 2025. Art drop-off day for approved entries is Saturday, September 6, 2025

Awards

Artwork will be juried on Monday, September 8, 2025. A maximum of 10 "Best in Show" pieces will be selected to receive a \$100 award. A maximum of 15 "Distinguished Merit" pieces will be selected to receive a \$75 award. A maximum of 20 "Honorable Mention" pieces will receive a \$50 award each. Student art will be judged separately. A student is defined as being 18 years of age and under.

Liability

Entries will be handled with all possible care but neither Georgia Artists with DisAbilities, Inc. nor Roswell Visual Arts Center will be held responsible for loss or damage from any cause whatsoever. Sending artwork to this exhibition shall imply an agreement on the part of the artist with the above conditions.

Touring Exhibition

A touring exhibition will be assembled from Best in Show, Distinguished Merit and Honorable Mention winners. Please indicate on the entry form if your work will be available for this tour. Some size limitations may be imposed for selection in touring exhibition.

If for any reason an artist declines for the artwork to go on tour, it will NOT be judged.

Sales

For insurance purposes, all artists must indicate on the official entry form the availability of his or her work for sale. The price must be stated on the entry form. Prospective buyers will be furnished with purchase contact information.

Artwork Return

For the winning artwork going on tour and not sold, it will be returned in August 2026. A <u>Georgia Artists</u> <u>with DisAbilities</u> representative will contact you when the artwork is ready for pickup. We will also coordinate delivery of sold art with the purchaser.
